
Music Lessons

When did you join?



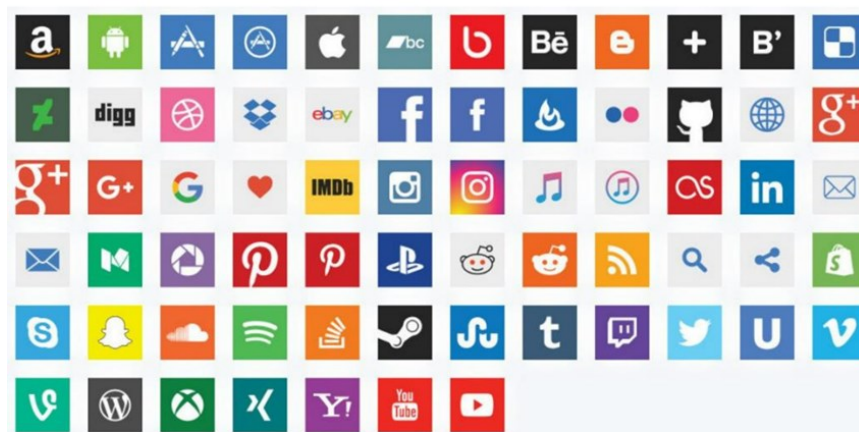

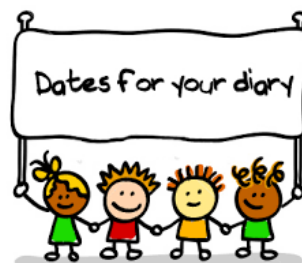
