Ashwater (Community) Primary School: Proposal to change the age range

Devon County Council is formally consulting on lowering the age range of Ashwater Primary School from 4-11 to 2-11 years of age from January 2023.

Household Support Fund

Please see a notice from the Early Help Team of Devon County Council

We are pleased to announce that we have access to further funding to support families on low incomes to support with food and utility cots. This is through the Household Support Fund.

Families on low incomes can get help with food and utility costs via the new round of the **Household Support Fund**, which Early Help are administering locally. The scheme runs until **31**st **March 2023**. Funds are limited, so when the allocation is used up we will close for applications.

We are pleased to announce that we have access to further funding to support families on low incomes to support with food and utility costs. This is through the Household Support Fund.

Families on low incomes can get help with food and utility costs via the new round of the **Household Support Fund**, which Early Help are administering locally. The scheme runs until **31**st **March 2023**. Funds are limited, so when the allocation is used up we will close for applications.

Through this fund, Early Help is able to provide a grant per family to support with:

- Food
- Supporting for energy and water bills for household purposes
- Essential white goods such as a fridge, freezer or cooker
- Consideration for petrol for essential journeys

The family needs to meet the following criteria:

- You are a family (at least 2 people where at least 1 person is either pre-birth or up to 18 years old)
- You are experiencing financial hardship
- You need financial help to pay utility bills or buy food and essential items linked to food, warmth, and utilities for your family
- Not have received financial assistance from another source for the same reason

Please note:

- Payment will be sent directly to families through BACS (it is essential we have the families bank details)
- There will be no food vouchers available in this scheme
- Only one application for an award per household within this round (HSF3) of the scheme, that will run from 16 November 2022 to 31st March 2023. Repeat

applications are unlikely to be successful.

- If a family have previously received hardship funding from Early help applications to HSF1 and 2 they will be considered. However, families who have not previously received funding will be prioritised

Recorder Lessons for Class 2

Anti-Bullying Week

Last week was Anti-Bullying Week. Teachers talked to the children about the importance of 'Reaching Out' if they were worried about themselves or someone else.

It is really important to encourage your child to tell a school adult if someone is unkind or bullies them. Children can feel worried about getting others 'into trouble' but in fact 'Reaching Out' is the way we can help. Usually, if the child who is being unkind or bullying has the opportunity to talk through and think about the impact of their behaviour with a school adult, they change their behaviour.


