What a Journey!

DT: This term, we are learning about different structures- what makes them strong, who designs them and what materials are used. As part of The Great Fire of London topic, Class 2 are going to be researching, designing, making and evaluating structures from 1666 and building their very own houses. Class 2 will also be learning all about a healthy diet, what makes a diet healthy and what portions are recommended.

Geography: linked with history, learning about London and then about the local area, physical and human features of Halwill and the UK. Looking at maps, globes and atlases learning about the different parts of the UK.

History: Taking a trip back in time, learning about The Great Fire of London, where it started, how it spread and what was done to stop the fire.

Science: Animals including humans is the topic this term, learning all about the human body, animals and how to stay healthy. This will also include how to keep our bodies healthy.

P.E: This term, Class 2 will be doing gymnastics, yoga and learning many different skills with 'Bude Haven'.

French: French will be filled with learning how to count to 20 and learning the names of colours, animals and many more! The Class also learn how to sing happy birthday.

R.E: Looking at what it means to be part of a faith community, what a variety of people and religions believe in and the celebrations of different cultures.
