## **Consultation on Change of Age Range**

## **Proposal**

It is proposed to lower the age range of Ashwater Primary School from 4-11 years to 2-11 years of age with effect from January 2023

## **Background**

Ashwater Primary School is a Community School maintained by Devon County Council for ages 4-11.

Ashwater Pre-School is a Governor run Pre-School, situated on the grounds of Ashwater Primary School and currently offers places to 2, 3 and 4 years olds.

Devon County Council is consulting on a proposal to lower the age range of Ashwater Primary School from 4-11 to 2-11 years of age from January 2023.

This proposal is concerned with the pre-school becoming part of the school rather than operating as an extended service. There will be no change in relation to the number of early years places currently offered and no change to the school's published admission number. If the proposal is approved, the main difference is that the pre-school will become a maintained Nursery Class, organised as a Foundation Stage Unit (Nursery and Reception class). Early Years staff will be employed directly by the school and children currently in the pre-school will be registered on the school roll, if the proposal is approved.

Parents will still need to make a separate application to Devon County Council for a place in the reception class.

#### **Capital**

No capital funding will be required by the School from Devon County Council. The proposal will not affect the capacity of the School, nor the Published Admission Number of 8 for ages 5-11 and will not put pressure on existing classroom space.

#### The Process

A proposal to change the age range of a Community School requires a statutory process to be followed which includes a six-week consultation period, followed by a formal four week representation period. The school and Devon County Council, as the decision-maker, will carefully consider all responses and we will keep you informed via: <a href="Have Your Say">Have Your Say (devon.gov.uk)</a>

The proposed indicative timetable is as follows:

Consultation period: Monday 12 September to Friday 21 October (6 weeks)

Formal representation period: Wednesday 2 November to Wednesday 30 November 2022. A Brief Notice will be published in the Western Morning News and a Full Proposal (along with a copy of the Brief Notice) will be published online at: <a href="Have Your Say">Have Your Say</a> (devon.gov.uk)

Proposed implementation: January 2023
